COMMON REGULATIONS COVERING BOTH EVENTS:

1. Taunton Motoring Club are organising a National 'B' Hillclimb on Saturday 1st & Sunday 2nd September 2018 promoted by Bristol Motor Club, Burnham on Sea Motor Club and Plymouth Motor Club at Wiscombe Park, Near Honiton, Devon, EX24 6JE.
 2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association, incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA, and these Supplementary Regulations (referred hereafter as SR) and any written instructions the promoting clubs may issue.
 3. The proposed programme for the meeting (where possible) will follow the timetable below:-
 - i) Scrutineering will start at 07:30.
 - ii) Practice will start at 08:30 and finish at 12:30pm.
 - iii) The first competitive run will be run at 1pm
 - iv) Any competitor not signed on by 09.30 MAY be excluded.
 4. The length of the course is 1000 yards (914 metres) consisting of several fast bends, two sharp left hand corners and one sharp right hand corner.
 5. Awards will be given as follows:
 - Fastest time of day - an award
 - 1st in each Class - an award (subject to 3 starters)
 - 2nd in each Class - an award (subject to 6 starters)
 - 3rd in each Class - an award (subject to 8 starters)
- No competitor may win more than ONE of these awards; additional awards may be added at the discretion of the organisers.
6. The maximum entry is 135 and the minimum is 80. The minimum number for each class is 4, should this figure not be reached the organisers reserve the right to amalgamate the class. No car may be entered in more than one class, or shared by more than two drivers.
 7. Practice will be in class and number order. All competitors will be given the opportunity of two practice runs which need not be timed. Competitors are advised to walk the hill prior to 08.30, but must ensure their car, helmet, fhr (if applicable), gloves and overalls are available to be scrutineered.
 8. Drivers of shared cars must ensure that the correct competition number is displayed on each run. Competitors are required to provide their own competition numbers in accordance with S.9.2.5. Numbers will not be available to purchase at the venue. The '2nd' driver will generally run in the batch order prior to the class in which the car is entered.
 9. Times will be displayed throughout the meeting. Provisional results will be announced after the completion of each class (GR D.26.1.1). Protests/appeals should be made in accordance with C 5.1 - 5.4.1 & C 6.1-6.4.
 10. Any road going competitor, unless in an invited Championship which has specific tyre rules shall comply with the following:

Classes A1-B3 should comply with S 11.6.2 and J 5.9.2. The onus of proving eligibility to use such tyres is the responsibility of the competitor.
 11. Cars will start singly in their own time after a green light signal. Method of timing is electrical, by breaking light beams at start and finish lines. ALL cars must be fitted with a timing strut as specified in S 10.9. The Finish will be marked with a Finish Banner above the course.
 12. Time permitting, drivers will be given at least two timed runs, the best time to count. Should circumstances not permit all of the class to be offered two runs, then only the first run will count.
 13. Entry fees will only be refunded as follows:-
 - a) Notification of withdrawal before closing date - full refund.
 - b) Notification of withdrawal after closing date and before dispatch of Final Instructions. Entry fee less a maximum of £15 administration charge.
 14. Competitors using non-pump fuel must indicate this on their Entry Form and at signing on.

Note 1: All cars must comply with S.10.1-10.9..

Note 2: All cars with engines running on diesel fuel will be subject to a 30% capacity reduction. eg. 2000cc diesel engines equate to 1400cc. All cars with engines fitted with forced induction will be subject to a 40% capacity increase, in the case of a turbo diesel (forced induction 2000cc less 30% = 1400cc+40% = 1960cc this applies to all roadgoing classes.

Note 3: Series Production cars are defined as cars complying with S.11.1.1, 11.3-5.1, 11.6.8. Specialist Production cars are defined as cars complying with S.11.1.2, 11 3-4, 11.5.2-8. Modified Limited Production Cars are defined as cars complying with S.12.1, 12 3-6.1, 12.6.3-12.9.2. Modified Specialist Production Cars are cars as defined as cars complying with 12.2, 12.3-12.5, 12.6.3-12.9.2. Sports Libre Cars must comply with S.14 and Racing cars with S.15. Rally cars must comply with R.46-49 AND S.14. Included in the latter category would be Group B cars, any cars without the original engine block of the model entered, and car with a transmission layout not as originally specified for that model, or a Specialist Rally Car without an engine complying with S.12.6.2. They need not be taxed.

Note 4: The onus of responsibility for the eligibility of vehicles competing in the championship rests with the Entrant/Competitor. In the event of a dispute concerning the compliance of a vehicle to the regulations, the onus will be on the competitor to satisfy the organisers, NOT the organisers to prove compliance. When completing the entry form drivers are reminded to indicate the event class and championship class (which may be different) for correct points allocation.

*Cars in this class must comply with the current MSA Technical Regulations for Stage Rallies (R.46.1 – 49.10.3). Cars need not be taxed, but must have a current valid MOT certificate. Cars must be presented for scrutineering with a valid MSA Log Book. Tyres marked "For Racing Purposes Only" are prohibited but otherwise tyre choice is free.

Note 5: **Entries for cars powered by Hybrid or Full Electric Engines will NOT be accepted for entry into this event.**

Note 6: **Any vehicle using Methanol must include an additive which provides a distinguishable colour and smell when burning.**
